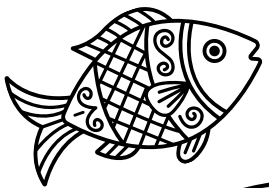


Poila Baisakh Celebration

Welcoming Students

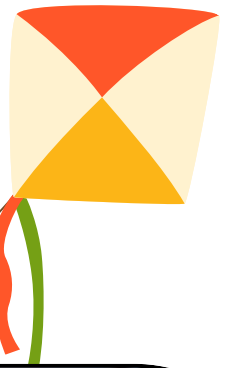
📅 6th April, 2026

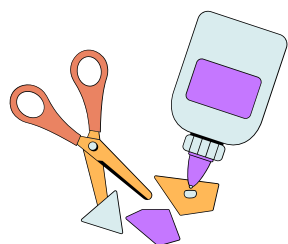
Mango Madness Day
